Welcome to SVEA, a project that addresses the use of web 2.0 skills by teachers and trainers in both VET and adult training institutions, with a special focus on personnel and organizational development.

Adult education providers are convinced of the advantages of web 2.0 applications

A lot of internet users link web 2.0 tools only with Youtube, Facebook and Twitter. It is however not sufficiently known that these applications can be implemented in a larger framework. The five SVEA partners (Wales, Germany, Italy, Spain and Belgium) have been researching to what extent adult education institutions are actively using web 2.0 applications and how they are integrating these possibilities into their educational offer.

To learn more about the benefits and the possible barriers the project partners have performed a thorough analysis. The most important conclusion is that providers of adult education are indeed aware of the importance of web 2.0. The effective use is often hindered by institutional and cultural barriers, not only by the trainer, but also on management level hesitation to integrate web 2.0 tools into courses is prevalent.

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Online platform offering custom web 2.0 tools for trainers and teachers

Based on the data from the regional analysis report, SVEA drew up a training program to educate instructors within the adult training sector in the use of social media.
